The items below are prerequisite for installation:


- Network cameras


### 01 UNPACK

# HARD DISK INSTALLATION


#### Step 1

Remove the front panel screws, and then remove the back panel screws.

#### Step 3

Insert **Disk 2** in the lower bay, connect a SATA power cable and SATA data cable 2 to the hard disk.





# **Step 2**Slide the case backwards until it stops, and then lift it up to remove.

Make sure you connect the correct data cable to the corresponding disk.

# MARD DISK INSTALLATION

#### Step 5

Lock Disk 2 using the disk screws in this sequence: A->B->C->D





#### Step 6

Repeat Step3~Step5 to install Disk 1 into the upper bay.




#### Step 7

Install the case in reverse order of removal step (see **Step 2**), slide the case cover back until it clicks. Lock the back panel with its screws. Do the same with the front panel.



# **05** CONNECTIONS

The diagram below displays an example connection setting using LAN1 to connect networks cameras within LAN



## START UP

- 1. Connect the HDMI monitor.
- 2. Connect the USB mouse.
- 3. Plug the power adapter into ENR and the electricity outlet.
- 4. Press down Power Button, and the power status LED will turn solid blue.
- 5. Connect ENR with your POE switch via LAN1 port.
- 6. Connect the network cameras to the POE switch.


# **07 LOGIN**



On Login window, input Account and Password with virtual keypad, and then click "Login".

Account : admin

Password: 123456



# **08 FORMAT DISKS**



On HDD Setup Wizard window, select the unformatted disk and click "Format". Repeat this step to format the other disk, and then click "OK".

# ADD CAMERAS



On Camera Setup Wizard window, click "Auto Add", input the Account and Password to access the cameras, and they will be added to the system.

# CHECK LIVE VIEW



After the cameras are added, you will immediately see live streams on **Live View** screen.

- To take a snapshot, select the channel and then click
- To view a single channel in 1x1 layout, double-click on the channel.



To validate PTZ operations:

- (1) Select a PTZ camera channel.
- (2) Click PTZ in the bottom left corner to open PTZ panel, and use the on-screen buttons to manipulate the camera.

The number of maximum supported live view channels will vary by ENR models.

# 11 CHECK RECORDINGS



On Live View screen, click Playback in the bottom right corner to entert Playback screen.



On the time bar, drag the current-time indicator to your desired position, and click on Playback control panel to play.

To export video, select the channel and then click
